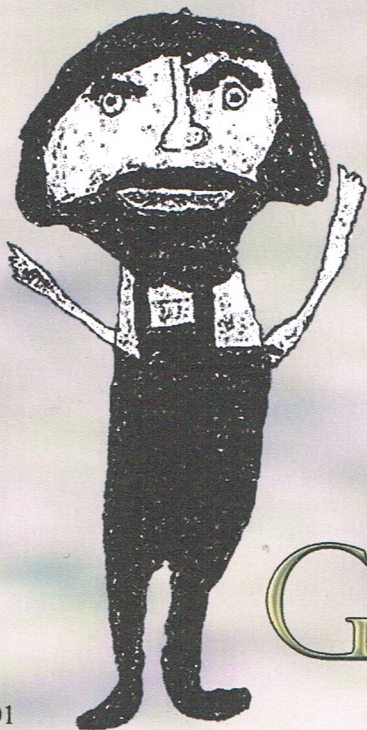


Dave Goulder has lived and worked in the north of Scotland since 1961. He is a master builder of drystone walls, and tours the Highlands and Islands on a motor cycle instructing in this craft. But it is as a song writer that he is best known in the outside world.

His songs have been performed and recorded by many artistes and are acknowledged as being among the very best of their kind. The ones recorded here are published in a companion book, *The January Man*.

An ex-railway fireman of steam locomotives, Dave has recorded and published collections of 'steam' ballads such as 'Requiem for Steam' and 'The Man Who Put the Engine in the Chip Shop'. He has also recorded a musical amalgam of his life in the Highlands titled 'Stone, Steam and Starlings' and a DVD/Video, 'How to Build and Repair Dry Stone Walls'.
